Qualifications

- Applicants must have graduated from a high school located in **Jefferson, Lewis or St. Lawrence** counties.
- Applicants must be pursuing a graduate degree in an approved music program of study. First preference is with one of the following institutions: State University of New York at Fredonia, State University of New York at Potsdam – Crane School of Music, The Julliard School or the University of Rochester- Eastman School of Music. See attached list for approved music programs of study.

Selection Criteria

Selection for this scholarship is based on educational objectives, ability to meet them, and financial need. Additionally, any unusual hardships and special family or personal circumstances should be described in the application. The scholarship amount is \$500.

Materials must be submitted as a complete packet in order to be considered for a scholarship. Packets must be received by June 1, 2019 – packets postmarked after June 1st will not be considered.

- _____ Official transcript(s) - *Request from your high school and or any college you have attended – you must include in your packet – will not be accepted if sent separately.*

- _____ References – On a separate sheet of paper please include the name, address and telephone number of 3 people, other than family members, familiar with your education and employment performance.

Mail or hand-deliver your packet (2-page application, essay, appraisal form, transcripts and references) to the Foundation at the address listed above. Notification of decisions will be mailed to all applicants by August 1, 2019.
