This geographic-specific fund was created in 2013 as a component fund administered by the Northern New York Community Foundation.

The Dale Kenyon Community Fund is designed to award grants annually to non-profit agencies enhancing the quality of life for residents in the town of Clayton. Three organizations received support totaling \$5,000 in 2015. The recipients were:

- Clayton Council of Churches Food Pantry \$3,000 for support of the local food pantry.
- Thousand Islands Performing Arts Fund/Clayton Opera House \$1,500 to assist with costs associated with the area's Clayton Jazz Festival performances.
- **Depauville Free Library \$500** to enhance the organization's seed library program.
