



Scholarship Rule and Application

Submit by July 31 or December 31 (limit 1 scholarship per year per person)

Mission/Purpose:

Through this scholarship program, The Women's Council of Realtors Tri-County NY Network aims to raise the level of knowledge, professionalism and leadership of REALTORS® in the communities we serve.

Eligibility:

If you have been a member of WCR Tri-County Network for at least a year, are licensed and actively practicing in New York State and hold a REALTOR® membership in New York State, you are eligible.

Completed applications must be submitted by July 31st for October awards and by December 31st for February

Recommendations may be from the broker or manager of the firm with which the applicant associated; from someone else familiar with the applicant professionally (such as a local board officer, a community civic organization leader or other professional).	t is
You must attach a letter explaining your motivation for applying (although scholarship awards are not based oneed, you may address any existing financial hardship), your future goals relating to the use of the scholarship, how you'd be willing to travel to a course and if you plan to maintain membership in WCR. A description of your communinvolvement, local board activities and any other information that might aid in the selection process may be included your letter.	far nity
