2020-2021 NORTH SIDE LEGACY FUND SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The North Side Legacy Fund was established in 2019 as a permanent fund of the Northern New York Community Foundation to forever honor and perpetuate the history and heritage of the North Side Improvement League.

Qualifications

- Applicants must be residents of **the City of Watertown**.
- Applicants must be **full-time undergraduate** students. Graduate study is **not** funded.
- Students who will be attending **technical** schools are eligible to apply.
- Applications are accepted from **high school seniors** for freshman year of college.
- Selection for freshman scholarships is based upon **academic achievement** and **personal data**.
- This scholarship is a **one-year** award.

Selection Criteria

Recipients of the North Side Legacy Fund scholarships are chosen based on student's combined regents scores, cumulative high school GPA, rank in class, personal data, essay scores and applicant appraisals. The mentioned criteria are entered into a database to produce a numerical ranking of all freshman applicants.

Instructions

Read all materials completely so you understand what is available, the criteria, and what is expected of you. **Materials must be submitted as a complete packet in order to be considered for a scholarship.** Packets must be received by June 5, 2020 – packets postmarked after June 5^h will not be considered.

- _____ Official transcript - *request from your school counselor – you must include in your packet – will not be accepted if sent separately.*
