# JEFFERSON COUNTY SONS OF THE AMERICAN LEGION BRIAN A. L'HUILLIER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Jefferson County Sons of the American Legion offers a scholarship of \$500 to qualified high school graduates. The scholarships will be announced at graduation. Entry into college must occur by the second semester after high school graduation. The first \$250 will be awarded at the time of high school graduation and the remainder of \$250 will be contingent upon the recipient submitting a transcript of their 1st semester college grades, which indicates a minimum average of "C", or a 2.0 cumulative index. If a "C" or 2.0 index is not obtained, then the remainder of the award is forfeited. Each candidate is required to complete a minimum of 12 semester credit hours per semester in order to receive this award. DEADLINE FOR FILING IS JUNE 1st

# Section 1

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- 1. Applicant must be a child, grandchild, step child or adopted child of a current or deceased member who is now or was at the time of death in good standing of the Jefferson County Sons of the American Legion, American Legion or Auxiliary. It is not a requirement that the applicant be a member of the Jefferson County Sons of the American Legion. Membership in the Jefferson County Sons of the American Legion is encouraged if the applicant meets the eligibility requirements for membership and preference will be given to those applicants provided the applicant meets the eligibility criteria as outlined below. Active membership in the Jefferson County Sons of the American Legion will be judged under "Involvement in Community Affairs"
- 2. Applicant must write a brief essay (250 300 words) giving evidence that he or she meets the remaining eligibility requirements listed below:
- a) Applicant has a personal commitment to the USA and its heritage and is proud to be an American.
- b) Applicant has a sense of obligation to his/her teachers, classmates and community.
- c) Applicant respects the flag of the USA, the symbol of our country.
- d) Applicant believes in democracy, freedom, justice, law and order.

#### Section 2

### Grading

The applicant will be judged and selected on:

- 1. Academic Achievement (50% value)
- 2. Participation in extra-curricular activities (25% value)
- 3. Involvement in community affairs (25% value)

#### Section 3

The scholarship committee shall be composed of:

- 1. Chairperson
- 2. Three (3) Executive Board Members of the Jefferson County Sons of the American Legion
- 3. County Advisor
- 4. One (1) member of Brian A. L'Huillier immediate family

NOTE: This committee will be advised by a high school administrator or faculty member as to the eligibility of the applicant per sections 1 & 2 above.
